













### Percent Population Change of Neighboring Counties











### Marion County, IA vs US, Growth in Firms-All Sizes & Industries, 2012-2022






#### **Average Number of Businesses Filing Sales Tax Returns, Marion County**
















Total Jobs by Year






Job Changes by Source






Jobs by Establishment Size














### Mid-Iowa Planning Alliance, Employment by County, Net New Jobs, 2012-2022

### Mid-Iowa Planning Alliance, Employment by County, Total % Growth, 2012-2022











### Percent Change in Number of Jobs 2010-2020










## **Resident Labor Force Participation by Age**




## Residents Not in the Labor Force by Age






### **Residents Not in the Labor Force by Sex**







## Out-Migration (Households), 2011-2021 Marion County, IA



# Growth by Industry, 2012-2022 Marion County, IA vs US, Salary














## **Property Type Breakdown**




## **Excess Housing Cost: 30% or More of Income**


## **Median Residential Property Value**




### **Median Home Owner Income**






## Percentage Owner Occupied Home Value








## Percentage of Population Below Poverty Level






## **Number of Households Below Poverty Level**


