
KNOXVILLE LABORSHED ANALYSIS UPDATE

A Laborshed is the area or region from which an employment center draws its commuting workers. A Laborshed analysis, in part, estimates the availability of labor for an area.

The most current Laborshed study conducted for the Knoxville Laborshed area was completed in August 2016. The following summary is an update to the initial Laborshed analysis based on current labor force participation and Census data.

EMPLOYMENT STATUS (ESTIMATED TOTAL)*




ESTIMATED TOTAL LIKELY TO CHANGE/ ACCEPT EMPLOYMENT IN



When broken out by occupational category the largest concentration of workers are within the professional, paraprofessional & technical category. The agricultural occupational category represents the smallest sector of workers who are currently employed.

CONCENTRATION OF THOSE LIKELY TO CHANGE/ACCEPT EMPLOYMENT IN KNOXVILLE



The estimated total of those likely to employment change or accept references those who would be likely to commute into Zone 1 (Knoxville) from their home ZIP for an employment opportunity. Employment demographic variables such as employment status, age, education level, wage and distance from Zone 1 are taken consideration when estimating the availability of these workers. The map to the left shows the concentration of those likely to change or accept employment in Knoxville within the Knoxville Laborshed area.

OUT COMMUTERS

Approximately 2,408 people living in Knoxville work in other communities. Of those, 31.8% (approximately 766 people) are likely to change employment if presented with the right employment offer.



The majority of residents in Zone 1 (Knoxville) are looking for positions within the production, construction & material handling and the professional, paraprofessional & technical occupational categories (approximately 737 people each). Residents in Zone 2 are primarily looking for positions within the professional, paraprofessional & technical occupational category (approximately 7,933 people) and residents within Zone 3 are primarily looking for positions within the managerial and the professional, paraprofessional & technical occupational categories (approximately 3,476 people each).

For the original analysis as part of the household survey portion of the Laborshed study an equal number of survey calls were completed into three separate survey zones. The three zones are classified as Zone 1) Knoxville, Zone 2) ZIP codes adjacent or near Zone 1 that have a moderate number of residents working in Knoxville or are within 20 miles of Knoxville and Zone 3) the ZIP codes in outlying areas with a low concentration of residents working in Knoxville.
