#### **Population Comparison with Peers**




## **Age Distribution**





## Marion County Population Percentage Distribution by Age, 2021








#### Jobs by Sector, Marion County, IA




#### New Jobs, 2011-2021 Marion County, IA


## Employment by County, Net New 2011-2021 Employment Partnership Service Area




#### **Percentage of Jobs by Size**




## Unemployment Rate, 2012-2022 Marion County, IA vs. U.S.













### Annual Growth in Total Personal Income, 2011-2021 Marion County, IA vs. U.S.






#### Salary Growth by Industry, 2011 to 2021











### Employment by County, Total % Growth, 2011-2021 Employment Partnership Service Area




#### 2017 to 2022 Industry Trends

Job Growth Trend: % Change, 2017 - 2022




#### 2022-2032 Forecast Industry Trends

#### 2017 to 2022 Occupation Trends














#### **Marion County Population by Race**




#### **Graduates by Degree Cluster**

Central College, 2011 - 2021







Graduate Growth: % Change, 2011 - 2021


















